Covenant Sunday

The term "covenant" comes from Jesus' words over the cup during the Last Supper: "This cup is the new covenant in my blood." (Luke 22:20) Since our worship is centered in the Eucharist, we are a community of the Covenant.

Each year on the last Sunday in September, we celebrate a special, single covenant-renewal Mass. During this outdoor Mass (bring lawn chairs!), the community is led in a ceremony to present individual Scrolls (a paper listing ministry commitments). Here, we renew our covenant way of life and embrace our three virtues: hospitality, spirituality and stewardship. The ministries of these virtues are found in this booklet. Every ministry needs leaders, assistants and participants!

Covenant Sunday Mass is followed by a Community Festival of food and fun.
